12. Village Environment

The burned out car on the Whinz has been removed. Chair to contact BDC to remove remaining debris.

Severn Trent Water to extend the drain and repair the hole in Low Road.

Some of the pot holes in Church Lane have been addressed in a very poor manner by filling with clumps of asphalt which is not level and obscuring the road markings in places. Notts County Highways are organising a meeting with Severn Trent to arrange a suitable repair. The Chair will also raise with them the matter of the repairs to the Great North Road near the bridge which are already beginning to break up.

13. Pilgrim Fathers Visitors Centre and Mayflower 400

The Chair to attend the meeting on the 23 March.

No response yet from the Land Registry in terms of the ownership and registration of the land upon which the Village Hall stands, necessary before solutions to the Village Hall extension proposals can be discussed properly.
